


2020-2021 IUPAC Member Login and Authentication Process (for CI Digital access)



In order for current members to access it, please login to www.iupac.org and follow the prompts below.

To make your email public: Click the box next to your email address and SAVE.



d. Phone Tab: You are able to update your phone numbers and make them public or private, similar to the email address.




